Health, Safety & Welfare Commitment

Policy Implementation and Management

To support this policy, comprehensive safety rules and general procedures will be issued and regularly reviewed. Management, in consultation with the company's appointed competent health and safety professional(s), will conduct periodic reviews and updates to ensure these rules remain effective, relevant, and aligned with legislative requirements and industry best practices. The structure of the company's safety organisation, together with the roles and responsibilities of individuals for implementing this policy, will be clearly communicated to all employees. The company fosters a culture of safety openness and transparency, encouraging all employees to actively participate in health and safety matters and contribute to the identification of hazards and opportunities for improvement.

Employee Engagement and Responsibilities

A-Gas Electronic Materials recognises that health and safety is a shared responsibility. It is the duty of every employee to:

- Familiarise themselves thoroughly with this policy and associated procedures.
- Take personal responsibility for their own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by their actions.
- Immediately report any unsafe conditions, practices, or incidents to their line manager or the health and safety representative.
- Cooperate fully with the company in adhering to all safety measures and training provided.
- Exercise their right to refuse work that they reasonably believe poses an imminent risk to their health or safety, without fear of reprisal.

Compliance and Training

The company is committed to full compliance with all applicable occupational health and safety legislation, standards, and any other relevant requirements to which it subscribes. To achieve this, A-Gas Electronic Materials will:

- Provide appropriate health and safety information, instruction, supervision, and training to all employees, contractors, and temporary staff to ensure their competence and awareness.
- Maintain records of all health and safety training and ensure refresher training is provided as required.
- Conduct regular risk assessments, safety audits, and inspections to identify hazards and verify the effectiveness of controls.
- Investigate all incidents and near-misses promptly to identify root causes and implement corrective actions to prevent recurrence.

Continuous Improvement

A-Gas Electronic Materials is dedicated to the continual improvement of its health and safety management system. The effectiveness of this policy and associated arrangements will be monitored regularly and reviewed at least annually or sooner in response to significant changes in legislation, operations, or after any serious incident.
